





Catalogue for revenue stamps of Saudi Arabia

The work of Thoden for the revenues of Saudi Arabia lives on with a new edition, thanks to an update provided by Martin Lovegrove. The work has not only extended but is now also put in colour. It takes a wile to get used finding something. The page numbers are groupe numbers who are not entirely alphabetical ranked. There will be a good reason for that. The pictures for the details are interesting! Normally it's an art to find such a stamp of it's own. The thought of being 2 or more varieties of it will not occur at that moment. If you may possess one of these revenues , you can find background information in a related appendix about it's reason of usage. Finally you can find a scarsity rating and value indication in the appendix K and L. Except for the popularity of this area you won't be able to sit first rank for a penny. From the approx 395 items I counted there is the following listing for the value indication:

There are reasons for indicating these revenues higher than the avearage ones. If you check auctions like Ebay you will have had it for that year if you have seen up to 50 stamps. Most of them are modern ones from passport pages which turned up lately. This work shows a fascinating history for revenues from the time of the fall of the Ottoman Empire till present days. For the collector a challenge to explore this area (more).

HUNGARY REVENUES

When finishing this issue I received this catalogue which I ordered only a few days before with payment. From this fast service a fast look throughout this work . That turned out to be an error because it was full of remarkeable aspects and so I started reading again. After an introduction with many watermarks displayed a section of forerunners from Austrian revenues and finally starting with Documentary stamps. Many sections will follow including preprinted documents. On page 66 a chapter for military border stamps in 1868 and from page 67 the municipals. From page 104 a section for the Russian Transsilvania ; the Carpates and 11 pages for Fiume. Generally most of the values are below £10 but a part of them up to £50 is not limited eather with excesses up to £200.....The proofs shown below are not lised but were sold on Ebay at the end of 2005 and fetched more than \$ 300,- . A collection area with many directions !


